

Our Lady of Good Counsel High School Vocal and Piano Scholarship Requirements

Students auditioning for a scholarship are reminded to arrive for their audition early in order to ensure that they will be heard. Students who arrive late may not be rescheduled due to time restrictions.

Audition requirements:

Vocal:

- A. Vocal Exercises- Applicants will be guided through some vocal warm-ups to assess vocal range.
- B. Prepare a song that you know well. It should be from church, school, or a popular or patriotic song. If available, bring a copy of the piano accompaniment or a recording of the accompaniment to sing along with. You are also welcome to provide your own accompanist.
- C. Applicants will take a brief quiz to test their knowledge of basic music theory.

Piano:

- A. Prepare a song that you know well. This should be a piece you have worked on with a teacher. Please bring the music with you, even if you can play it from memory.
- B. Vocal Exercises- Applicants will be guided through some vocal warm-ups to assess vocal range as pianists are also required to sing in the choir that they are assigned to.
- C. Applicants will take a brief quiz to test their knowledge of basic music theory.

Audition slots are 15 minutes in length
